



Meeting and Event Safety Protocols

The following are the IACP Meeting and Event Safety Protocols. Any updates of these protocols will be posted and shared with registered attendees prior to the event.

Before Leaving Home:

- Stay home if you feel sick.
- Follow relevant guidance provided by the [World Health Organization \(WHO\)](#), [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](#), and/or your local health authority.
- Adhere to government issued travel restrictions and guidance issued by the region you will be traveling to and the region from which you are traveling.

On-site During the Event:

- Follow guidance from the local health authority for everyday preventative actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses including:
 - Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or an alcohol-based sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
 - Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
 - Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing. Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Temperature checks are required before entering the meeting/event venue.
- Face masks that cover your face from the bridge of your nose to past your chin are required. Neck gaiters, bandanas, and masks with exhaust valves are not acceptable face coverings.
- Adherence to physical distance protocols put in place by the venue or state is required.
- If you feel unwell or are experiencing flu-like symptoms you should seek medical attention.

Any attendee not adhering to the guidelines will not be granted access to the event and/or will be asked to leave.

Post-event:

Based on current contact tracing advice from many health authorities, if you test positive for COVID-19 up to 14 days after returning home, please contact the meeting/event organizer to advise them at conference@theiacp.org.
